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



Hot-rolled steel prices vs. lead times


SMU's hot-rolled steel prices and lead times, with data through March 5, 2025.





Steel mill lead times by product


SMU lead times on new steel orders by product through March 5, 2025.





Steel mill negotiations


SMU's price negotiations on new steel orders by product through March 5, 2025.





Hot rolled inflection point


When do you think steel prices will peak?





Future hot rolled prices


Where do you think HRC prices will be in two months?


Prime scrap prices in March will be:

Compared to two weeks ago, how is your company handling spot pricing to your customers?






How did your company perform last month compared to your forecast?





Steel buyers' sentiment Down 4 points to +62


SMU's current steel buyers' sentiment index, with data through March 5, 2025.





Steel buyers' future sentiment Down five points to +60


SMU's future steel buyers' sentiment index, with data through March 5, 2025.





Service center inventories history


SMU's flat rolled product shipping days of supply, with data through January 2025.





Foreign vs domestic HR prices Foreign prices include \$90/st in importing costs, Asian prices include a 25% tariff


SMU's HR coil price vs. CRU offshore HR coil price, with data through March 6, 2025.





Import volumes down. But for how long?


US Department of Commerce total US steel imports, monthly imports through February 2025 license data

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Current U.S. Tariff Measures

IEEPA Int'l economic emergency (fentanyl/migration)	Section 232 National security (steel & aluminum)	Section 301 Unreasonable trade practices (China trade war)
China: Effective February 4/March 4 20% on all products	Effective March 12 25% on steel and aluminum imports from all sources (including derivative products) are additive (232 + IEEPA + 301 + AD/CVD)	25% on wide range of Chinese products
Mexico: Effective March 4 0% for all USMCA compliant products 10%for non-USMCA potash 25% for all other products		
Canada: Effective March 4 0% for all USMCA compliant products 10% for non-USMCA energy products & potash 25% on all other products		



Potential U.S. Tariff Measures

Reciprocal	Shipbuilding	Other
Reciprocal tariffs on all sources Effective date and tariff level TBD (April 2?)	Potential fees on inbound and outbound ships owned/operated by Chinese companies, as well as fleets that contain Chinese owned ships Effective date TBD	Autos, semiconductors, pharmaceuticals, copper and lumber Effective dates TBD

Practical Issues (IEEPA)

IEEPA Tariffs on China

- Apply to goods that Chinese or products of Hong Kong under the "substantial transformation test"
- At 10% from February 4 March 3; rose to 20% effective March 4
- Tariffs apply in addition to Section 301 or other applicable tariffs (e.g., 232)

IEEPA Tariffs on Canada and Mexico

- Tariffs apply to goods that are Canadian / Mexican under the "substantial transformation test" or 19 C.F.R. Part 102 Rules
- <u>USMCA Exemption:</u>
 - Effective March 7; goods entered March 4 to March 6 are not eligible
 - The exemption <u>does not</u> apply to all goods from Canada / Mexico. It is available only to goods that meet the complex, product-specific rules of origin under USMCA Chapter 4
- Tariffs apply in addition to other applicable tariffs (e.g., 232)

Practical Issues (Section 232)

- All prior country-specific special treatment (exemptions, quotas) and Generally Approved Exclusions revoked
 - Product-specific exclusions to expire at the end of their current terms without renewal
 - No future special treatment or exclusions contemplated
- Aluminum tariffs increased from 10% 25%
- Coverage expanded to new tariff codes, including codes outside of Chapters 72/73 (covering steel mill goods and steel articles) and 76 (covering aluminum "mill" goods and articles)
 - For the additional goods outside of Chapters 72/73/76, duties apply only to value of steel/aluminum content
 - CBP has issued Cargo Systems Messages with information on how to report duties on these goods
 - All duties effective March 12 including on the steel/aluminum portion of non-72/73/76 goods
 - If importer cannot segregate the value of the steel/aluminum content, may choose to pay duties on full value
- Potential for further expansion to additional articles
